- □ 1. The bachelors degree is the equivalent of 124 credit hours specific to the general education and the major/minor requirements.
- \Box 2. Of the 124 hours, 40 must be upper-level {3000 & 4000}.
- A student completing an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science Degree (not a technical degree) from an accredited state (Oklahoma) Junior or Community College, has fulfilled all general education requirements at ECU. Sixty-four (64) hours from a state junior or community college is the maximum number of hours that will be accepted by ECU (e.g., if a student has 90 hours, only 64 of those hours will apply towards their degree at ECU or any other 4-year state university).
- □ 4. For transfer students, regardless of the number of hours transferred from a junior/community college, 30 hours must be completed at ECU and 60 hours from a senior-level institution. The last 15 hours must be completed on campus.
- 5. Unless waived by the Admissions and Records Office, all students must complete the general education requirements of the Freshman Seminar UNIV 1001, and the General Education Seminar UNIV 3001. (Transfer students may be exempt from UNIV 1001 and UNIV 3001, but must apply for a waiver). These requirements are met if a student has earned an associate degree, as specified in #3 above.
- □ 6. Zero-level course work cannot be applied to the required 124 hours.
- \Box 7. All social work majors must select a minor.
- □ 8. Dropping, withdrawing, failing a course or courses and/or earning a grade below a "C" in a major course in any semester will adversely effect completion of the required 124 hours and may extend the time/semesters needed to complete the degree.
- □ 9. Although students may declare a major in social work, there is a formal admission process. Social work majors are eligible to apply for admission to the program based on the following:
 - a. Complete approximately 45 semester hours with a GPA of at least 2.25.
 - b. Attainment of a grade of "C" or better in English Composition I and II.
 - c. Attainment of a grade of "C" or better in Introduction to Social Work and Social Welfare; and a grade of "P" in Field work Studies in Social Work.*
 - d. Completion of Introduction to Sociology; General Psychology; and completion of a <u>human biology</u> course (General Biology will fulfill this requirement).
 - e. Personal qualities of the student which demonstrates behaviors and attitudes consistent with social work values and ethics.
 - f. Positive recommendation from two references.
 - g. Recommendation of Social Work Program faculty.

*No social work major will be allowed to take any social work course beyond Introduction to Social Work and Social Welfare and Field Work Studies in Social Work until they have been formally admitted to the Program.

- 10. The approved Plan of Study (which is completed after admission) will guide the student in completing his/her degree in a planned and organized way. However, digression from the Plan may result in the student not completing their degree in a timely manner. All amendments to the Plan of Study must be approved in advance by the student's Social Work advisor. Ultimately, it is the student's responsibility to monitor their own degree plan and to be familiar with the contents of the ECU Catalog, as well as all Social Work Program materials distributed to them.
- □ 11. At the completion of approximately 80 hours, it is the student's responsibility to request an official degree check from the registry office. The request form must be signed by the advisor.
- □ 12. Students must have a retention GPA of 2.5 to be eligible for internship.
